### Dear Future Teacher,

The Springfield Education Association (SEA) offers the Sue Handy Scholarship to students pursuing a career in public school teaching, honoring Sue Handy's contributions to education. The scholarship is available to graduating seniors from District 186 or students with a parent or guardian employed by the district, as long as they attend a public school.

Recipients will receive \$2,500 over four years: \$500 annually for the first three years, and \$1,000 in the fourth year. To maintain eligibility, students must remain enrolled in a teacher preparation program.

## To be considered for the scholarship, please submit the following:

- Resume: A professionally formatted, typed resume outlining your relevant experience, including academic achievements, volunteer work, tutoring, leadership roles, or any other relevant skills or qualifications.
- **Personal Essay**: A typed, two-page, double-spaced essay discussing your motivation to pursue a career as a public school teacher, and identifying the individual(s) who have inspired your decision to follow this path.
- Letters of Recommendation: Two letters of recommendation are required. One letter must be from a current or former teacher who can speak to your academic abilities, work ethic, and potential as a future educator. Please note that letters of recommendation will not be accepted from relatives.
- **Unofficial High School Transcripts**: Submit a copy of your unofficial high school transcripts to provide insight into your academic performance.
- **Proof of College or University Acceptance:** Provide documentation confirming your acceptance into a recognized college or university within a teacher preparation program.
